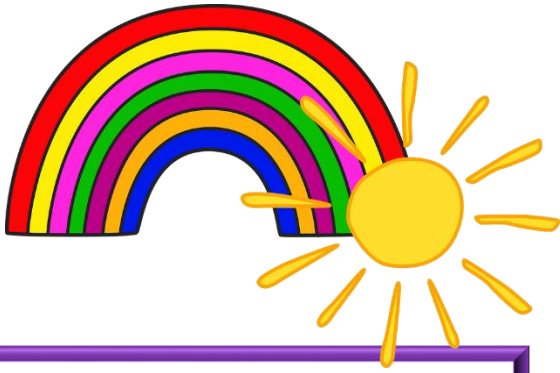
**Home Learning**
