English

- **Reading**
- Ask questions to improve their understanding
- Draw inferences such as inferring characters' feelings
- Predicting what might happen from details stated and implied
- Summarise the main ideas
- Identify how language, structure and presentation contribute to meaning
- Authors use of language, including figurative language
- Distinguish between statements of fact and opinion

- **Writing**
- Use further prefixes and suffixes and understand the guidance for adding them
- Spell some words with 'silent' letters [for example, knight, psalm, solemn]
- Continue to distinguish between homophones and other words
- Using a wide range of devices to build cohesion within and across paragraphs

- **Grammar**
- Use passive verbs to affect the presentation of information in a sentence
- Use the perfect form of verbs to mark relationships of time and cause
- Use expanded noun phrases to convey complicated information concisely
- Use modal verbs or adverbs to indicate degrees of possibility
