Free School Meals

If your circumstances have changed, you may be eligible for Free School Meals (this is different from the universal free school meals that all children in years R, 1 & 2 are entitled to). First Admission to School for September 2021

Children born between 1st September, 2016 & 31st August, 2017 are due to start school in Reception in the school year starting September, 2021. Parents need to make an application, even if their child currently attends a nursery class at the same school.
