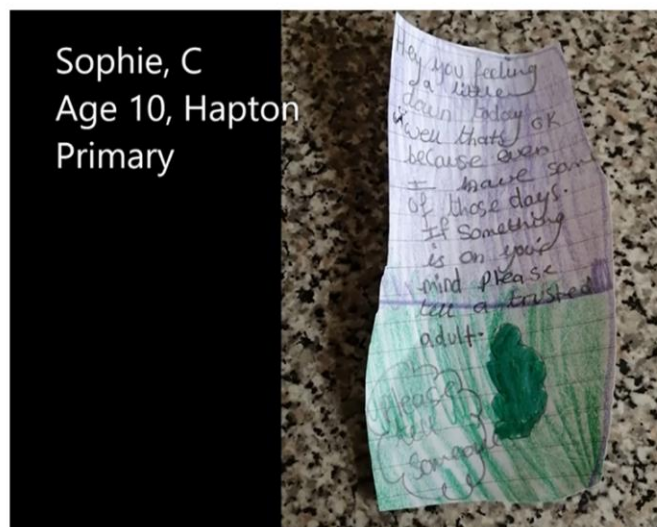

The government announced last year that all statutory testing will not take place during this academic year. This covers both KS1 (year 2) and KS2 (year 6) SATs, the year 1 phonics screening check and year 4 multiplication check.
