We will not allow children to return to school if only a LTF has been used; you will need to get a PCR test, either by booking at a test centre or getting one online and delivered by post.

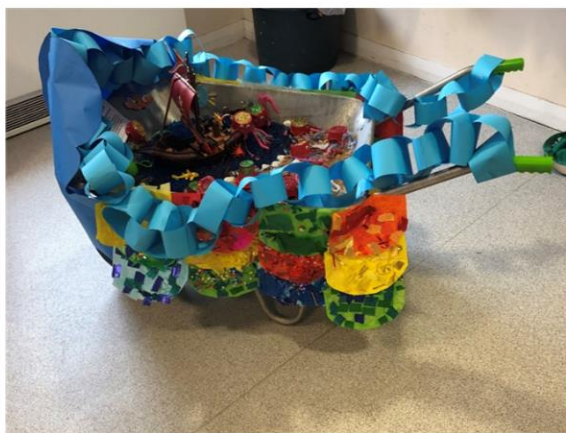
St. Andrew's Preschool
