Warmer Weather

Can I please remind parents & carers, now the warmer weather has arrived, children should be encouraged to wear sun hats when outside. Please ensure your child has sun cream applied before the school day, which they can top up during the day if required. Any sun cream coming into school must have the child's name on it. Children will not be allowed to share sun cream with their peers due to allergies.

Leavers' Services

This year, we will be holding our leavers' services outside on school grounds, but are only inviting the parents of Year 6 children.

Covid Symptoms

As a reminder, the current symptoms of Covid 19 are as follows:

- **A high temperature** – this means you feel hot to touch on your chest or back (you do not need to measure your temperature)
- **A new, continuous cough** – this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if you usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual)
- **A loss or change to your sense of smell or taste** – this means you've noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal

Children who attend school displaying any of these symptoms will be sent home and must either get a PCR test (not a Lateral Flow Test) or isolate for 10 days.
