## COVID Guidelines

### Positive Lateral Flow Tests

From 11 January in England, people who receive positive lateral flow device (LFD) test results for coronavirus (COVID-19) will be required to self-isolate immediately and won't be required to take a confirmatory PCR test. Positive LFD test results will still need to be reported to the government website.

### Self isolation reduced to 7 days for those with negative LFD tests as follows

Following a positive test result you should self isolate for 10 days, however, LFD tests can be resumed from day 6 (and must be taken 24 hours apart) - when two consecutive negative results are received and only providing you have no raised temperature, isolation can end. After day 10, you may end self-isolation even if a LFD test is positive, providing you have no raised temperature.

Those who leave self-isolation on or after day 7 are strongly advised to limit close contact with other people in crowded or poorly ventilated spaces, work from home and minimise contact with anyone who is at higher risk of severe illness if infected with COVID-19.

### Close contacts

If you are aged 5 years and over and have been identified as a contact of someone with COVID-19, but are not legally required to self-isolate, you are strongly advised to:

- take an LFD test every day for 7 days, or until 10 days since your last contact with the person who tested positive for COVID-19 if this is earlier
- take this daily test before you leave the household for the first time that day.
