I graduated in English and completed my postgraduate teaching qualification at the University of London. My teaching career started in 1978 and took me from Norfolk to Hertfordshire, Scotland, France, Hungary and back to Norfolk in 1995 when I joined the teaching staff at a rural primary school. I was seconded for two and a half years to work for Norfolk LA as a Literacy Advisor and then returned to the same church school as Reception Class teacher, SENCo, Deputy Headteacher and staff governor in 2002.
