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We will be reading The Last Wild by Mini Grey and Between Tick and Tock by Louise Greig. We will be using these stories to write in a variety of ways including; traditional tales, free verse poetry and narrative. We will also be writing biographies in our history lessons about famous nurses. Please Remember to read at home for 5 minutes a day and make a note in your child's reading record.

Computing

What do you know about algorithms? We'll be learning how to write an algorithm to make cakes! Delicious.

RE

What do Jews remember on Shabbat? We will explore this question using the Jewish story of Shabbat.

Music

Warm up those vocal chords as we'll be doing a lot of singing this term. We'll be learning to sing a variety of songs and looking at notes.

Art

We are learning about Henry Moore and his sculptures and will be trying out our own sculptures.

Science

We will observe and describe weather associated with the seasons including how day length varies. After half term we will learn that animals, including humans, have offspring which grow into adults; describe the basic needs of animals, including humans, for survival; and describe the importance for humans of exercise, eating the right amounts of different types of food.

Maths

We begin this term by identifying and sorting 2D and 3D shapes by identifying their properties. We will then move onto money; learning to recognise and count coins and notes. Later in the term, we will explore multiplication and division by using arrays. We will finish the term by learning about fractions (halves, quarters, and equivalents) as well as beginning to tell the time.
