

English

This term we will be reading Jack and the Beanstalk, The Last Secret Garden by Linda Sarah and The Bee Who Spoke by Al MacCuish. We will be using these stories to inspire us to write a range of texts including descriptive writing, story writing, diary writing and persuasive letters. We will continue to hone our oral skills through frequent debate and discussion. Please remember to read at home for 5 minutes a day and make a note in your child's reading record.

Science

Our science work this term will be closely linked to the nature around us. We will be focusing on being able to identify and name common wild and garden plants and trees. We will also learn the basic structure of plants and trees as well as discover what they need to grow strong and healthy. We will also observe the stages of plant growth.

Maths

We will start the term on exploring measurements, measuring, and comparing length and height, mass and volume. We will also look at temperature and reading scales. We will then move on to Statistics, creating pictograms and bar graphs and interpreting results. We will also look at position and direction.

Computing

This term, we will focus on coding, our understanding of algorithms and how they can be implemented on digital devices.
