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Science

The first half term we are learning about Earth and Space. We will be looking at the movement of celestial bodies and conducting research. We will hypothesise and consider the reliability of research. This will be followed by 'Animals, including Humans'.

Maths

Place value is on the agenda for the first few weeks of term; we will be continuing to develop our partitioning skills using both standard and non-standard methods. We then move onto geometry where we will be learning all about right angles and different types of lines such as parallel and perpendicular. During the run up to Easter, we will turn our attention to multiplication.

Computing

In computing this term, we will be creating vector drawings using online applications. We will be exploring how objects can be manipulated for a given effect.

RE

We will be exploring the following big question:

What can we learn about the world/knowledge/ meaning of life from the great philosophers?

Music

Humanities
