

English

Using the book 'Street child' by Berlie Doherty, we will be writing a variety of different text type, working alongside our history topic of the Victorians. Over the term, we will be concentrating on fiction and non-fiction genres including recounts, setting description, diary writing and poetry. We will be developing our comprehension skills, understanding how to retrieve information from a text and make inferences to build our understanding.

Science

The first half term we are learning about electricity. This will be followed by learning about forces. We will be conducting a range of experiments where we will make predictions using our scientific knowledge and use fair testing to test our theories and draw a conclusion.

Mathematics

In Maths., Year 5 will be looking at place value, including recognising numbers up to 1,000,000 and rounding within these numbers. We will also be looking at different calculation strategies as well as developing their understanding of fractions. In the second half of the term, we will be looking at calculations including multiplication and division.

Computing

In Computing this term, we will be learning about photo editing. We will change a digital image by colouring, cloning and combining as well as creating and evaluating an image.
